Kennedy Health System doctors are honored

Rewards program set to encourage recycling

RecycleBank, a rewards program that motivates people to recycle, recently announced that it planned to start a pilot program in 850 households in Cherry Hill to improve recycling rates.

Cherry Hill is one of five municipalities in the state to partner with RecycleBank to provide an easy-to-use and proven recycling rewards program.

The Knollwood neighborhood will receive new 96-gallon containers Oct. 19, and the first day of RecycleBank pickups will be Oct. 26. The new containers are for all recycled products. Residents will no longer need to separate glass from paper or cardboard from plastic.

RecycleBank measures the amount of material each home recycles and then converts the amount into RecycleBank reward dollars, which can be used at hundreds of local and national rewards partners.

Cherry Hill resident on behavioral care board
